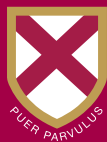

# FINANCIALLY ASSISTED PLACES

Under the umbrella of the Charity Commission's public benefit guidelines, the Governors of Cranmore School have set aside financial provision to help parents who wish their sons to join us but who might otherwise be unable to pay the fees to have their boys educated at Cranmore.

Therefore, no parent in our catchment area need feel that Cranmore is unaffordable.

Cranmore welcomes boys from all religious denominations. Cranmore's ethos is central in supporting the boys' spiritual and social development, so that pupils leave our School equipped with the life-benefiting attributes of trust, tolerance, care and concern for others.

Our "Financially Assisted Places" scheme provides relief for up to 100% of fees. Boys who join us on this scheme will be eligible to apply for similar bursaries at senior schools when they leave at age 13.

We are offering our "Financially Assisted Places" to all who are not already in independent education, subject to a means-tested review of a family's financial circumstances. The selection and award of places will be at the sole discretion of the School.



# AT CRANMORE SCHOOL

## What are Financially Assisted Places?

Financially Assisted Places are awarded by Cranmore to boys in each school year group between Year 3 and Year 8 in a scheme that gives parents up to 100% fee relief depending on their financial circumstances.

## Do we qualify?

With a gross assessed family annual income of **£27,500** or less your son could be eligible for free education at Cranmore.

At a higher level of annual assessed income on a sliding scale up to £60,000, a contribution to fees will be expected where 50% fee relief will be paid by the School.

In keeping with all boys who join Cranmore at these ages, your son will need to have attained our usual academic entry standard.

## How do we apply?

If you would like your son to be considered for our Financially Assisted Places scheme, you will need to register him using our standard registration form (available from the School upon request). Please note that the usual registration fee of £75 will *not* be required.

You will then be invited to bring him along to sit our entrance test held in January each year.

Although financial assessment takes place after a boy has been awarded a conditional place, *we strongly recommend that you contact our Bursar in order to obtain a provisional financial assessment prior to your son taking our test.* The Bursar will then be happy to advise you of the approximate level of fee relief you might expect to receive.
