

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR NEW PUPILS

THE SCHOOL SHOP

The shop is open **by appointment only**, on selected weekdays during the summer from 2nd July to 23rd August. The appointment system is for parents' convenience and **an appointment is essential for all uniform fittings. You should bring your child with you for the fitting.** For maximum choice of times and dates, please reserve your appointment as soon as possible after receiving this leaflet. All new pupils should be fitted before 23rd August and we strongly advise that you don't wait until the end of the holidays to come for your fitting.

Making an Appointment

For all children joining in September, please telephone our **dedicated appointments line at the School Shop office on 020 8687 6842**. Appointments cannot be made at the School Shop. Please note that the Cranmore School Office is unable to make an appointment on your behalf and we are unable to do fittings on the 'Taster' Days before the end of the summer term.

For children moving up from Cranmore Nursery to Lower Prep in September, an appointment is needed and fittings cannot be done during normal term time opening hours.

For children joining during the academic year, please call our office on 020 8687 1502 to book an appointment.

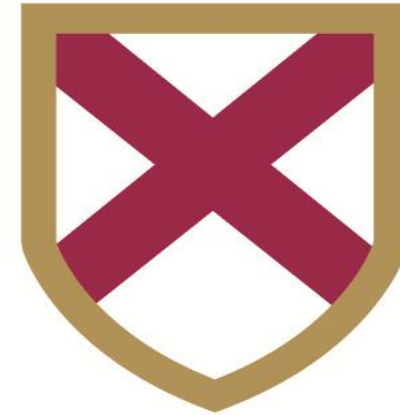

Nursery and Junior Department

GIRLS

Pre-Nursery - No formal uniform requirement

Nursery

- Sweatshirt navy badged
- Cardigan navy badged
- Jog pants maroon
- Polo shirt maroon or gold badged
- 'Waterproof' suit for use in Forest School – may be sourced anywhere
- Wellington boots
- Gym shoes with Velcro
- Optional legionnaires sunhat for summer

Instead of jog pants, girls can wear a grey skirt or grey pinafore sourced anywhere.

In the summer they can wear shorts, leggings or dresses (which must cover their shoulders) sourced anywhere.

Please note that 'spare' clothes should also be uniform.

IMPORTANT NOTE REGARDING LABELLING

It is essential that all items of clothing including gameswear, socks and underwear are clearly marked with the pupil's name. Please see separate order form for personalised nametapes. *All items marked with an asterisk must be labelled with a large one inch I.D. nametape, with maroon lettering on white background. This label should show first initial and surname e.g. J. SMITH. This is nametape ref NW8 on our order form. Please ask in the Shop for a separate leaflet giving instructions on where labels should be attached to each garment

Backpacks

A backpack is needed by all pupils (except Nursery), to carry homework bag and a snack. A selection of bags is available in the School Shop. Please note that wheeled backpacks are not permitted in the Junior Department. These are for Seniors only.

Form 1 - Stationery

A small zipped pencil case is required, with 3 quality HB pencils, a set of coloured pencils, a large Pritt stick, a 15cm ruler and an eraser.

Form 1 – Sports Kit

Please note that children joining in Form 1 or moving up to Form 1 and needing a replacement track suit, should purchase the Senior track suit instead of the maroon jog pants and jog top.

In the Summer Term, if representing the School, cricket kit will be required by children in Form 1. Pupils **do not** need white trousers in Form 1.

Form 1 – Uniform

Please note that girls joining in Form 1 should wear the navy skirt. Girls moving from UP to Form 1 may continue to wear their navy pinafore until needing a replacement when a navy skirt should be purchased. Navy skirts must be worn from Form 2.

All items are available in the School Shop, including white trainers and black studded velcro fastening football boots but not school shoes.

Junior Department

- School blazer

Summer Uniform

The floral summer dress should be worn with white socks, either ankle or knee length. It may be worn after Easter but must be worn after May half term until the end of the School year. It may be worn from September through to October half term.
